Enhanced safety and precautionary measures

- 1. A check point is set up at each hotel lobby, The Magellan Sutera Resort and The Pacific Sutera Hotel. Guests are expected to go through a temperature check upon arriving at the hotels prior to check-in or patronizing the restaurants and recreational facilities. Those with high fever or other symptoms may undergo additional screening. When checking in, all hotel guests are also asked to fill out a questionnaire enquiring about prior China travel.
- 2. The Resort is fully prepared with sanitizing facilities for both guests and employees. Scheduled cleaning of all contact and touch points as well as isolation procedures for any suspected cases. Emergency and extraordinary preparedness are part and parcel of hotel standard operating procedures (SOP).
- 3. Our public areas, rooms, restaurants, hotel linens, dining crockeries, cutleries etc. go through stringent sanitation for the convenience of our guests. Safety measures include: installation of additional hand washing and hand sanitizing stations in public areas of the hotels and in common areas frequented by guests and employees.
- 4. Notices in public areas are in placed to inform guests about the situation and protective measures they can take.
- 5. Any guest with an abnormal body temperature will be advised to seek treatment at our local government hospital Queen Elizabeth Hospital Kota Kinabalu, Sabah.



- 6. The same procedure applies to employees of Sutera Harbour Resort. All employees are reminded to practice strict hygiene habits at all times.
- 7. Training in transmission prevention are deployed, which incorporates guidelines from the World Health Organization (WHO).
